## Vanpool Facts . . . Did you know?

- The number of vanpool vans in the active fleet today is 321 (292 on the road, 28 spares & one ramp-accessible van).
- Of the 150 employers Pierce Transit vanpools serve, The Boeing Company Renton site has the most Pierce Transit vans, followed by the City of Tacoma.
- Lengthiest daily commute is 135 roundtrip miles.
- Approximately 2,500 volunteer participants commute in a Pierce Transit vanpool.
- Overall average ridership growth for the year was 7.9%
- Total vanpool miles driven were 4,343,719.
- We have had no serious injuries in our history of operation (since 1986).
- 44% of vanpool accidents were at fault and 79% of at fault accidents were due to volunteer drivers colliding with **fixed** objects.
- 82% of vandalisms occurred in locations other than homes (grocery stores, Park and Ride lots, and worksites).

# **Tacoma Traffic Nightmares**

Please note that the on and off ramps connecting Sprague Avenue and eastbound SR16 are closed. Getting from the Tacoma Narrows to Interstate 5 will take a lot longer as they build a new SR16 Nalley Valley viaduct.

WSDOT plans to help manage traffic flow on eastbound SR16 during construction with ramp meters at Jackson, Pearl, Orchard, Center and Union. This project will take about two years to complete. Do you receive a paper voucher, such as a Commuter Bonus Voucher or TranBen Voucher, from your employer as part of your vanpool payment? If so, please print your name and company on the front or back of the voucher, either in the space provided for that purpose or somewhere that does not interfere with our endorsement of the check. This ensures we properly apply vouchers to eligible individuals.

Occasionally, new vouchers are introduced for payment. Volunteer bookkeepers, please contact your vanpool coordinator to verify acceptance of any new or different vouchers.

## **Saving Vanpool Maintenance \$\$**

We allow cash purchases on the Voyager card for items that you need for the van, i.e. windshield wiper fluid, De-Icer, and headlight bulbs. However, avoid labor charges such as a bulb change, by scheduling an appointment with Pierce Transit for any simple replacement of items you are unable to do on your own. The general rule of thumb is: if it's something we would normally fix, Please contact us to arrange for the repair.

Help us to better serve you. If you need to visit your Pierce Transit vanpool coordinator in person, please make an appointment with her ahead of time. This ensures she will be available when you arrive. If you arrive without a pre-scheduled appointment, your vanpool coordinator may not be available.

Fall Back - Sunday, November 1




#### **Upcoming Defensive Driving Orientation and Bookkeeping Classes**

Defensive Driving/Orientation classes are listed above. Each class must have a minimum of five Pierce Transit volunteer applicants registered. We generally hold Bookkeeper classes from 3 p.m. -4 p.m. on these Wednesdays and from Noon -1 p.m. on these Saturdays.

We must receive all applications at least one week prior to the date of the class in order to pre-approve and schedule you for that training.
