

Second Amendment  
to the Interagency Agreement  
between Pierce Transit and Sound Transit  
for  
ST Express Bus Service Operations and Maintenance  
2010

This is the Second Amendment to the Interagency Agreement between Pierce Transit and Sound Transit for ST Express Bus Service Operations and Maintenance 2010 ("Agreement").

Recitals:

- A. This Agreement, after the exercise of two one year options to extend the term, will expire on December 31, 2014.
- B. Pierce Transit and Sound Transit are negotiating a new operations and maintenance agreement to replace this Agreement; however, negotiations will not be complete before this Agreement expires.
- C. The parties wish for the term of this Agreement to be extended to give the Parties additional time to negotiate the new operations and maintenance agreement.





The Parties therefore agree as follows:

Subsection 20.2 is amended to read as follows:

**20.2 Term**

This contract shall expire on December 31, 2012, with an option to extend for two additional one-year periods and one additional six-month period.
