New Bus Routes

Four new routes serving the Ruston, Port of Tacoma, East Tacoma, and Puyallup areas



New Stream Lines

Convert Routes 1, 2, and 3 into high capacity transit Stream lines (buses arrive every 15-20 minutes)



More Frequent

Buses for 18 routes arrive every 30 minutes on weekends (compared to 4 routes currently)



More Paratransit

Increased hours, later service, and the ability to serve more customers with disabilities



Later Service

Most routes operate until at least 10 p.m. on Weekdays and Saturdays, and 8 p.m. on Sundays



Regional Connections

11 routes adjusted to improve local circulation or connect with Sound Transit stations

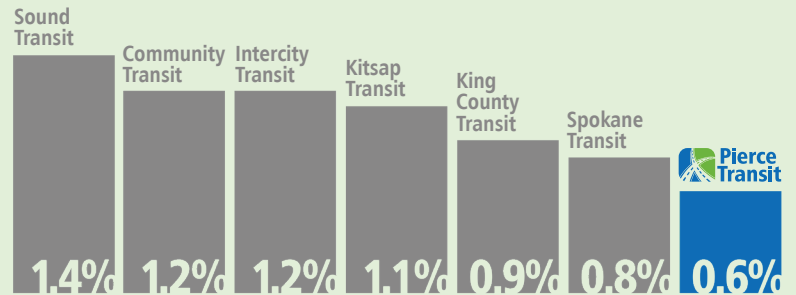
What It Costs & How It Works

Rapid growth in Pierce County is straining our transit system. Our primary source of funding, a 0.6% sales tax, hasn't changed since 2002. If voters approve a 0.3% (or 3¢ per \$10 spent*) sales tax increase, we have a plan to deliver what our community has asked us for: transit that serves more people, more places, more often.



We would receive an extra **3 cents** on every qualifying **\$10** purchase in our service area.

Compared to Peer Transit Agencies in Washington



You DON'T Pay Sales Tax On:

- Rent or Mortgage
- Groceries
- Most Healthcare



You DO Pay Sales Tax On:

- Dining
- Clothing
- Electronics

What does a 0.3% sales tax increase look like?

- \$10 Sandwich = **\$0.03**
- \$20 Sweater = **\$0.06**
- \$80 Electronics = **\$0.24**
- \$225 Furniture = **\$0.68**
